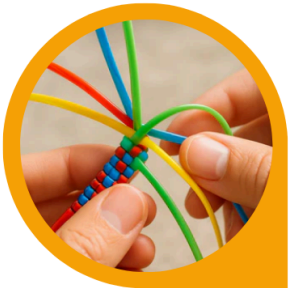

We celebrate our connections and our diversity

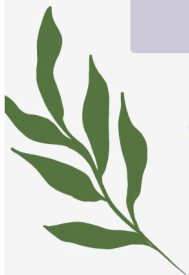
We care for one another and for ourselves
